We are excited about your participation and look forward to working with you to ensure you get what you need out of this mission.



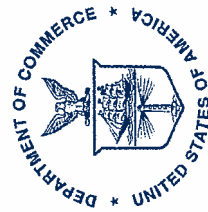
